how to unmark a Pigeon at Basketing

Occasionally, a pigeon needs to be UN-marked at Basketing ... this could be due to reasons including:-

- Assignment displayed not matching life ring number
- Pigeon considered to be unfit to race by the basketing team or the fancier

Here's how to do it:

1. Pigeon is basketed
2. If pigeon needs to be UNMARKED press STOP button

3. When asked if you want to “**Print right now**” click CANCEL
4. Click the green-coloured PIGEONS button, this will call up all basketed pigeons

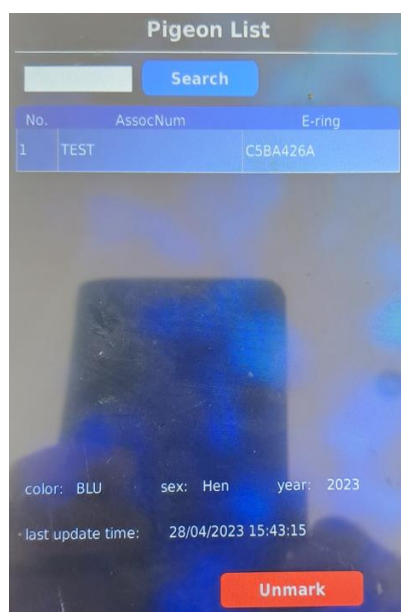

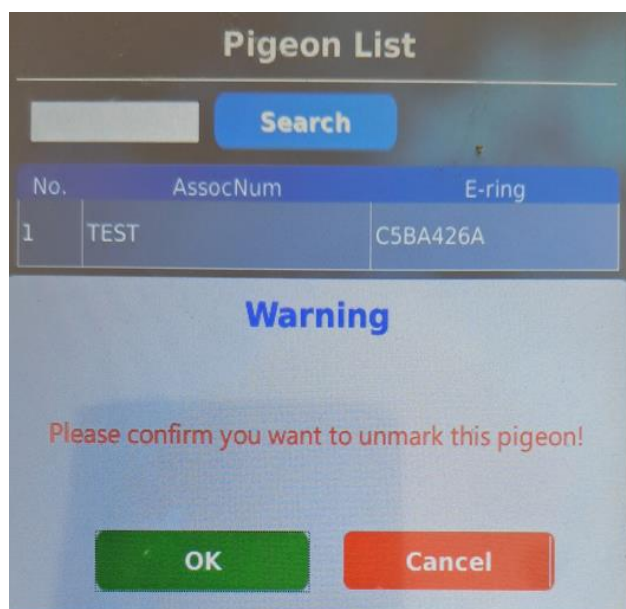
Press <Start> to mark!

5. Navigate to and select the pigeon to be UNMARKED
6. Click red UNMARK button



7. Click OK to confirm you wish to UNMARK the pigeon



8. Return to Basketing screen
9. To resume Basketing click START
10. To end basketing click STOP
11. Answer "**Print right now**" question with OK
